
St. Lawrence Lodge Outdoor Resident Visits June 17, 2020

During outdoor visits at the Lodge, all necessary precautions must be taken to prevent exposure to Covid-19. **The following requirements must be met by visitors. Any visitor non-adherence to these requirements will be the basis for the discontinuation of their visits.**

- All visitors are required to provide proof of a negative Covid-19 test within the past fourteen (14) days. Please bring a printed copy of your test results.
- The current schedule allows for one (1) visitor at a time per resident per week.
- Visitors will adhere to the thirty (30) minute scheduled visit appointment time allocation.
- Visitors will only visit with their loved one and no other residents.
- Visitors must be feeling well on the date of the visit.
- Visitors must pass the active screening in order to be granted access to the visiting location. Anyone failing the screening will not be granted access.
 - Visitors have a responsibility to answer the questions honestly.
- Visitors must bring their own mask or face covering and wear it at all times during the visit.
- Physical distancing will be maintained at all times.
 - Failure to do so will result in your loved one having a Covid-19 test completed and they will be placed under contact pre-cautions protocols.
- No deliveries or trading will take place.
 - Do not bring food, coffee, or other beverages for the Resident.
- Visitors must bring their own portable chair to use during the visit to reduce cleaning requirements.
- No pets will be allowed into the visiting area.
- Outdoor visitors will not have access to the Home's washroom facilities.
- Respect the visiting protocols that have been put in place. Please ask if you do not understand them.

Procedure

A - Booking a Scheduled Visit

Scheduled outdoor visits are available **starting Monday June 22/20**, as follows:

Monday to Friday
9:00am to 12:00pm
12:45pm to 5:00pm

Family will contact the Home in advance to arrange a date and time for the visit. Please call Sylvia Heliotis at 613-345-0255 ext 4104.

Visits will be a maximum of thirty (30) minutes in order to allow all residents the opportunity to schedule a visit with their loved ones.

B – Arrival at the Home on the Day of the Visit

Please do not arrive until 10 minutes before your scheduled visit – to avoid crossing paths with other visitors.

Visitors will use the designated parking spaces located in the North Parking Lot adjacent to the Visiting Area.

Wait for the Screener to invite you to the Visiting Area to complete your active screening prior to the start of your visit. Follow all instructions provided to you by the Screener.

C – Exiting After Your Visit

The Screener will advise you when your scheduled visit is due to end.

Maintain physical distancing from your loved one even though it may be extremely tempting to embrace physically with your family.

Exit the Visiting Area along the designated route, return to your vehicle, and exit the property in a timely manner.

D – Other Information

In addition to the above requirements for visitors, the Home reserves the right to cancel outdoor visits at any time should the risks be considered too high, including:

- Visitors or residents not complying with the rules in place.
- The Home is considered to be in full outbreak.
- Adverse weather conditions (rain, heat advisory).

Make sure to use the handwashing stations located in the Visiting Area, wear your mask, and always maintain physical distancing during your visit.

We have done our best to keep your loved ones and those caring for them protected and safe during this pandemic. As we re-open to visitors, we ask for your cooperation and adherence to these rules, as each of our actions has an impact on many other people.
